2. Application criteria

Individuals or teams composed of two to five undergraduate, or international students of member universities of the Consortium of Universities in Osaka.

*Any team composition is acceptable, including mixed teams with members from different universities, seminars, or clubs.

3. Presentation topic

Choose either of the following topics:

Topic 1:

What can students do to achieve the objectives of the Osaka Declaration toward Zero Plastic Waste?

Aiming to be a leading city in SDG achievement, the Osaka Prefecture has been developing measures to recycle plastic and reduce pollution from plastic waste. For this initiative to expand independently, there must be a change in the mindsets of municipalities, businesses, prefectural residents. Please present a proposal for an activity or program that students can implement to promote the achievement of this goal.











Topic 2:

A proposal for the realization of the Osaka model smart city project.

The Osaka Prefecture aims to become a model smart city and resolve various social issues such as demographic changes, urban infrastructure reconstruction, "new town" developments, and meteorological disasters. Please present a proposal for how the Osaka Prefecture can achieve its vision of a "sustainable city" using advanced technologies.

4. Presentation format

- The duration of the presentation is 20 minutes (15 min for the presentation, 5 min for O&A).
- The presentation must completely be in English (including the materials).
- · Please use mainstream presentation software (e.g., PowerPoint).
- The use of costumes and props is permitted.
- · If presenting as a team, all team members must speak.
- The content of the presentation must have been created by the applicant(s).

5. Judging criteria

Presentations can be awarded with up to 100 points and will be judged as follows:

Content	Was the content consistent with the topic? Was it original and persuasive in its logical development?	30 pts.
Verbal Presentation	Did the presenter communicate to the audience (i.e., language, expressions, and volume of voice used) in a straightforward manner?	15 pts.
Impact	Was the presentation convincing to the audience?	15 pts.
Visual Presentation	Were the slides well designed and easy to understand?	25 pts.
Q&A: Effective Response	Were clear responses provided for each question?	15 pts.

6. Awards

Awards will be given to the first- through third-place winners, as well as to the winners of the judge's special awards.
